To access Slide Transitions Click Transitions tab.



Transitions tab gives you a list of options you can use

#### Add Slide Transitions > Add Same Slide Transition for all Slides

#### Toadd slide transitions :

- Under Thumbnail, Select the Slide
- Click **Transitions** tab and choose the desired transition
- If you need more transition, click the dropdown arrow.





#### Toapply transitions to all slides :

- Under thumbnail, hold control key and select all the slides
- Click Transactions tab
- Select the desired transition
- Go to **Preview tab** and Click **Preview** to view the effect implemented
- Under the Timing tab Click Apply To All
- The effect gets applied to all slides.





Add Slide Transitions > Add Same Slide Transition for All Slides

You can modify a transition by changing its direction.

To modify transitions:

- Select the slide with the transition you want to modify
- Click Effect Options
- Choose the desired option
- Click Preview



#### Add Slide Transitions >Customise Select Slide Transitions

#### To add sound transitions :

- Go to **Timing** tab
- Click the **Sound** option
- Select the 'no sound' option.

#### To remove sound transitions:

- Go to **Timing** tab
- Click the **Sound** option
- Select the 'no sound' option.



Add Slide Transitions > Configure Transition Start and Finish Options



#### To add duration to slide:

- Go to **Timing** tab in the Menu bar Click the **Duration** box
- Type-in duration
- · Preview it on the same tab

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#### Add Slide Transitions > Configure Transition Start and Finish Options

To advance slides automatically:

- Go to Timing
- Click After
- Set the time to show the slide automatically based on the requirement.









Add Slide Transitions > Configure Transition Start and Finish Options

#### To advance slides manually:

• Go Timing ribbon, Check On Mouse Click

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Add Slide Transitions > Configure transition start and finish options

To remove transitions :

• Under the Transition to This Slide ribbon, Click None to remove the transition.



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#### Add Animations > Animate Text and Graphic Elements

Adding animations to the text and objects or images:

- Makes the presentation very attractive and beautiful
- Give the presentation the visual and sound effects including movements
- Helps to focus on important points, control the flow of information, and attract your audience's interest

#### Add Animations > Animate Text and Graphic Elements



#### Entrance effect:

- Controls how the objects should enter in the slide.
- Examples effects are Appear, Fade.



#### Add Animations > Animate Text and Graphic Elements

#### **Emphasis effect:**

• Emphasis important points.



#### Add Animations > Animate Text and Graphic Elements

#### Exit effect:

- Controls how the objects should exit from the slide.
- Examples effects are Fade, Split.



#### Add Animations > Animate Text and Graphic Elements

#### Motion Paths effect:

Controls how the objects should move from the one place to other and the path.



#### To add animation:

- Select the text or object
- Click Animation tab> Under Animation ribbon, Select the drop-down arrow
- Select the Preferred animation effect



#### Add Animations > Animate Text and Graphic Elements

- Slide will have a star mark
- · Object has a number which represents the sequence of animation



#### Manage Animation Effect Option:

- Select the object
- Click Animation > Under Advanced Animation, click Effect Options > select the preferred direction





#### Add Animations > Animate Text and Graphic Elements

To add multiple animations to an object:

- Select the object
- Click Animation tab> Under Advanced Animation ribbon
- Click Add Animation > select the preferred animation



#### To modify Emphasis Effect Options:

- Select the object with animation
- Click Animation > Under Advanced Animation ribbon, click Animation Pane> The Animation Pane gets opened on the right side.
- Expand the animation > Select Effect Options



#### Add Animations > Animate Text and Graphic Elements

When an object has more than one animation, each animation effect will be represented by a number.



Numbers indicate the sequence of animation.

#### To animate using Motion path:

- Select the object
- Click Animation
- Expand Add Animation
- In Motion Paths Select the Preferred animation effect, E.g. Arcs
- Motion path gets added with an indication of Green marker for beginning point, and Red marker for End point.
- Drag and adjust the beginning and end path as needed.



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#### Add Animations > Animate Text and Graphic Elements

• To rotate the effect, click the bar near the center of the effect.





## To modify / apply an effect which is not in the default list:

- 1. Select a new object in the slide which does not have animation
- Click Animation tab > expand Advanced Animation ribbon, click More Entrance Effects



#### Add Animations > Animate Text and Graphic Elements

#### To animate using Motion path:

- Change Effect pop up window appears.
- Check Preview Effects option to have preview before applying
- For this example, select
   Dissolve In > Click OK



#### To animate group of text:

- Select a paragraph in text box
- Click Animation> select Zoom
- Click Effect Options > select By Paragraph



#### Add Animations > Animate Text and Graphic Elements

- To have a quick preview, in Animation ribbon, click
   Preview
- You can also select the **Play** button from the Animation Pane.





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#### Animate using Animation Painter:

- Select the object
- Click Animation > Under Animation ribbon, Select the Preferred animation
- To copy the animated object, Click Animation Painter
- Click on object where you want to paste the animation





#### Add Animations > Order Shapes, Images, and Text Boxes

• Let us draw a blue color triangle and a yellow rectangle one over the other as shown.



## Reference Frances of Vertical-

#### Add Animations > Order Shapes, Images, and Text Boxes

#### To send an object behind:

- Select the rectangle
- Do right click > Click Send to Back > Select Send Backward
- Notice the yellow color rectangle sent behind.



#### Add Animations > Order Shapes, Images, and Text Boxes

#### To bring an object Forward:

- Select the rectangle
- Do right click > Click Bring to Front > Select Bring Forward
- Notice the yellow color rectangle is at front again.







#### Add Animations > Order Shapes, Images, and Text Boxes

• Let us draw an orange color circle above these two objects.



#### Add Animations > Order Shapes, Images, and Text Boxes

#### To send objects Back:

- Right click on Orange circle
- Click Send to Back > select Send to Back
- Now, the orange circle is behind of other two objects







#### Add Animations > Order Shapes, Images, and Text Boxes

#### To bring objects to front:

- Right click on Orange circle
- Click Bring to Front >Bring to Front
- Now, the orange circle is above other two objects.



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#### Add Animations > Order Shapes, Images, and Text Boxes

#### To Connect line between objects:

- 1. Draw circle and rectangle
- 2. Click Insert > Click Shapes > Select line
- 3. Connect the middle green marker of the circle to the middle of the rectangle

Add Animations > Group Shapes, Images, and Text Boxes

To animate grouped objects:

- Select group
- Click Animation tab> under Animation ribbon, select Appear



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#### Add Animations > Group Shapes, Images, and Text Boxes

- To view the animation, under Advanced Animation, select Animation Pane
- As you can note the animation get applied to the entire group.
- To preview, click Play From

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#### Add Animations > Group Shapes, Images, and Text Boxes

To rename the animated image:

- Select the object
- Click Shape Format tab, Under Arrange ribbon, Click Selection Pane >Selection Pane appears
- Double click on the preferred object > Type new name > Press Enter





#### Timing animation effect:

Select an object with animation > click Animation tab > under Advanced Animation ribbon, click Animation Pane



#### Add Animations > Configure Animation Effects

- In animation pane, select the animation that you want to change
- In **Timing** ribbon, in **Start**, change from **On Click** to **After Previous**

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#### To change animation Duration:

- 1. In animation pane, select the animation
- 2. In **Timing** ribbon, Click **Duration**, type-in the required value. Note that it is in seconds.

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#### Add Animations > Configure Animation Effects

#### Add delay between animation:

- 1. In animation pane, select the animation that you want to change
- 2. In **Timing** ribbon, in **Delay**, type-in the delay in seconds

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• In the Animation Pane, right click on the animation effect that you want to remove and then click on Remove.



#### Add Animations > Configure Animation Effects

- Select the object
- Click Animation tab > Under
   Animation ribbon, Click None



- Select the animation number that appears on the object and press delete key from keyboard.
- To remove animation from multiple objects, select all objectives and press delete key.





#### Add Animations > Configure Animation Effects

#### To turn-off all animations:

- Click Slide Show > Under Set Up ribbon, Click Set Up Slide Show
- Under Show options, select
   Show without animation > click
   OK





#### To view Animation Timeline:

In Animation Pane, right click • on animation > select Show Advanced Timeline.

In the timeline, you can view

- The type of animation such as • Entrance, Emphasis or Exit;
- How long the animation will play; and
- What is the sequence

#### Add Animations > Reorder Animation on a Slide

#### To reorder animation sequence:

- In Animation pane, select the • animation that you want to reorder
- ٠ In **Timing** ribbon, Click **Move** Earlier / Move Later, as needed

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#### Add Slide Transitions > Key Takeaway

- Add transitions which help to fill the gap between one slide to other during a presentation
- Add transitions to one or multiple slides
- Modify the direction of the transition by using effect options
- Control the timing of the transition
   as per the requirement
- Add Sound effect to the transition

There are four major animation effects

- Entrance
- Emphasis
- Exit
- Motion path

Using the features available in MS PPT you can:

- Add animations to objects
- Modify the animations
- Animate using motion path
- Group shapes, images, and text boxes
- Animate grouped text
- Copy animation from one object to the other
- · Time your animation as per need
